Friday 3rd of October

Arrival for camping at Tregedna Farm from 12pm.

Camping and caravan area is visible on the right-hand side once entering the farm and following the lane past the trees and play area.

If you are arriving with a caravan or camper van, please be aware that the limited number of electric hook ups are on a first come, first serve basis and will cost an additional £5 per night over and above your camping fee.

This is payable in cash at **Official** Registration, we regret that due to demand we are unable to reserve these pitches.

If you are arriving to camp with a tent, pitches are again on a first come, first serve basis, don't worry there is more than enough space on the campsite for everyone, Sea Kayaking Cornwall have exclusive use of the campsite and campsite facilities for the weekend.

If you have any queries and are uncertain of the camping area, please report to the Sea Kayaking Cornwall cabin and have a friendly chat with a Sea Kayaking Cornwall team member.

Additional parking is available in the lodge carpark. Follow the signs to the "lodge" and stroll down to the Sea Kayaking Cornwall cabin. Please do not block access roads and lane.

If the camping arrangement is clear to you, please get set up at your own leisure, relax and we will see you at the **Official Registration @ 4pm.**

Please note, all camping fees are handed-over directly to Tregedna Farm including optional electric hookup fee. Sea Kayaking Cornwall does not profit from these charges.

Arrival for Tregedna Lodge/Bunkhouse at Tregedna Farm from 3pm. Please follow signs to the "lodge" which are visible on arrival at the end of the lane.

Names and room allocation will be listed and visible on the main door on entry to the lodge and again on each individual room door. Rooms are located below the communal lounge and kitchen area and are accessed by a stairway on the left, shortly after entering through the main door. Room keys will be in the doors, please do not remove keys if you are in a communal bunk room so that late arrivals have access to their beds.

Parking is available in the lodge carpark on the left, clearly visible on arrival at the lodge.
